Deutsche Bank Kindles the Spirit of Giving

Sparkling performances also entertained the crowds. The bazaar opened with a performance by children from Singapore Creations Etc., a non-profit performing arts company that aims to empower young people through the performing arts. Wrapping up the bazaar were the ladies from HOME, an anti-human trafficking organisation, who added to the festive atmosphere with Christmas carols.
